The San Diego Sex Offender Management Council's (SOMC) Mission is to design and implement a comprehensive plan to enhance the management of sex offenders in San Diego County.

SOMC is a community management system that includes law enforcement, advocacy, monitoring and treatment that work together to educate the community for the prevention of sexual assault.

This curriculum is meant to be a community education tool. The objective is to dispel myths about sex offenders and their behaviors; to understand San Diego County's commitment to effectively manage sex offenders; to increase awareness; to prevent further sexual victimization; to identify benefits and limitations of community registration and notification and to identify resources that provide services to victims, offenders and families.
